



## Happy Holiday Poinsettia Treat Wrap

Make 'n Mold Treat Bags (6 in x 3.75 in)- Poly

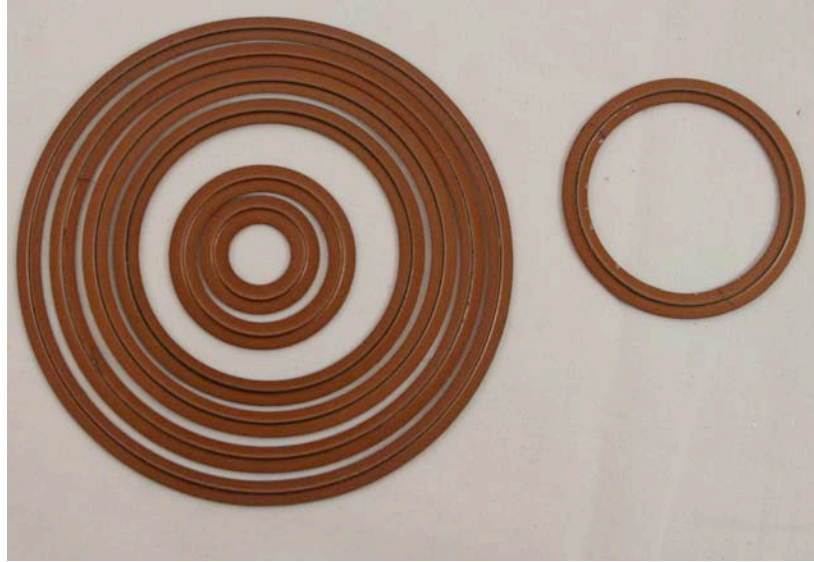

### Directions:

1. Die cut the treat bag with AccuCut's Bag Treat Wrap (3-D) Crease Extra Long Cut Die using Merry & Bright Paper. This die from AccuCut cuts and creases your project. Fold on crease lines. Fill your poly treat bag with Hershey's Chocolate Kisses. Place chocolates inside the Treat Wrap to determine how full your bag needs to be to sit properly. Make any necessary adjustments. Fold over the top of the poly bag and staple twice to secure kisses in the bag. Next place the kisses in the Paper bag treat wrap, make sure that it will indeed stand and staple the poly bag to the front of the bag treat wrap. **Tip: before stapling ensure that the flap from the backside of the wrap will cover your staples.**
2. Next place adhesive on the tab on the backside of the wrap and adhere to the front of the wrap. You have now assembled your bag treat wrap.
3. To decorate your bag treat wrap – choose a designer border from the A Merry Christmas Border and Centers stamp set. Snap the border into your 1 5/8" wooden stamper. Next select a designer center and snap it into the center of your 1 5/8" stamper.
4. Ink the image using Memento Bamboo Leave ink and stamp on cream cardstock. Use Red & Silver Spica Pens to color in the image.

5. Die cut the stamped image with Spellbinders Standard Circle Nestabilities - Small. To die cut a 1 5/8" image use the 3<sup>rd</sup> die from the center. (This die is exactly 1 5/8")



6. Use WorldWin Doublemates Berry Red Paper and the Spellbinders Nested Poinsettia die to diecut two Large Poinsettias and a Medium Poinsettia. To assemble your Poinsettia use the light red side of the Large Poinsettia for the back of the flower, then use the dark red side for the second Large Poinsettia for the second layer of the flower and then the light red side for the medium Poinsettia. Emboss all the three layers of the Poinsettias with the textile embossing folder. **(be careful to emboss the correct side of the papers)**. Now assemble your Poinsettia embellishment as shown in the picture above. Use foam mounting tape between each layer to give additional dimension to your poinsettia.
7. Purchase a stem of glitter leaves from Michael's- cut one section from the leaf and place it behind the Poinsettia embellishment you have created and use double sided foam mounting tape to secure the leaves to the back of the flower and then the entire embellishment to the front of the treat wrap bag.
