



Merry Christmas to You Wreath Bag Treat Wrap

Make 'n Mold Treat Bags (6 in x 3.75 in) - Poly Bag
Offray Red Velvet flower

Directions:

1. Die cut the treat bag with AccuCut's Bag Treat Wrap (3-D) Crease Extra Long Cut Die using Oh Joy Mitten Mitten. This die from AccuCut cuts and creases your project. Fold on crease lines. Fill your poly treat bag with Hershey's Chocolate Kisses. Place chocolates inside the Treat Wrap to determine how full your bag needs to be to sit properly. Make any necessary adjustments. Fold over the top of the poly bag and staple twice to secure kisses in the bag. Next place the kisses in the Paper bag treat wrap, make sure that it will indeed stand and staple the poly bag to the front of the bag treat wrap. **Tip: before stapling ensure that the flap from the backside of the wrap will cover your staples.**

2. Next place adhesive on the tab on the backside of the wrap and adhere to the front of the wrap. You have now assembled your bag treat wrap.
3. To decorate your bag treat wrap – choose a designer center from the A Merry Christmas Border and Centers stamp set. Snap the center into your 1 5/8” wooden stamper.
4. Ink the image using Memento Lady Bug Red ink and stamp on cream cardstock. Use a 1 1/2” scallop punch to punch out your image. Using a 1” circle punch, punch a 1” circle out of scraps. Use this circle as a mask and color the outside edge of you scallop with a red copic marker. Set image aside. (Optional – you can make the stamped image glimmer by spraying it with V2 Vellum adhesive and sprinkle it with crystal glitter. Use your fingers to wipe off the excess glitter.)
5. To create your wreath, Use Spellbinders Nestabilities Classic Scalloped Circles, small and Spellbinders Nestabilities Classic Inverted Scallop Small dies. For the outer edge of your largest wreath, use the fifth scallop die from the center and the 3rd die up in the nest of Classic Inverted Scallop dies.



6. For the smaller wreath use the fourth Classic Scallop Die from the center and the same inverted die you used for the large wreath. Place both dies on your paper and die cut each wreath with one pass in your diecut machine.



7. Spray the small wreath with V2 Vellum Spray and add Acorn Glitter to the wreath. Rub your finger over the glitter to remove excess glitter. Set aside to dry.
8. Die cut a Berry Red Cardstock mat for the wreath to be mounted on using the 5th die in the Standard Circle, Large Nestability.
9. Assemble your wreath as shown in the photo using foam mounting tape.
10. Spray the velvet flower with V2 Vellum spray and sprinkle with Crystal glitter. Brush off excess glitter.




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
